Primary by introducing and implementing policies and procedures, monitoring, coaching and mentoring and championing the involvement of mathematics throughout the life of the school. Faye was a member of the school's Senior Leadership Team, playing an important role in the school's Outstanding Ofsted inspection (2014)

Faye has recently been seconded to Bishop Martin CE Primary to improve Mathematics across the school. Faye has provided staff training through staff meeting and INSET, most recently focusing on the National Curriculum, Mastery approaches and assessment.
